Hey NDCers! Every Sunday morning, anywhere between 40 to 50 kids participate in NDC Kids. NDC Kids allows parents to fully engage in church and, let's be honest, gives them a much-needed break. Meanwhile, the kids (ages 0-11) are playing games, doing crafts, and hearing Bible stories through age-specific curriculum that helps them start building foundations for their relationship with Jesus. In short, NDC Kids is a big deal! But here's the thing: Sundays are run completely by volunteers. As our community continues to grow, we're facing a good problem—we need more help.
