Generations: A Brief Introduction

IN CASE YOU MISSED THE FIRST SUNDAY OF THE SERIES

This January and February, NDC is stepping into a new sermon series focused on Generations—not as a way to divide us, but to help us better see, understand, and love one another.

Our church community is beautifully diverse. On any given Sunday, as many as six generations gather to worship, serve, and follow Jesus together. In this series, we'll primarily focus on the four main adult generations represented at NDC today: Boomers, Gen X, Millennials, and Gen Z. Each generation carries its own stories, values, questions, wounds, and hopes—and all of them matter.

The goal of this series is threefold. First, we want to celebrate the generational diversity that already exists among us. As mentioned on Sunday, our church may be one of the few places where you regularly experience this level of generational diversity. There is a tremendous opportunity here! Second, we'll explore some of the meaningful differences between generations, particularly as they relate to faith and their perspectives on the world. And finally, we hope this journey fosters deeper empathy, stronger community, and greater unity across generational lines.

The series will begin with two overview messages from Norton, going over each generation and what history and technologies have shaped them, as well as some fun cultural moments from each. From there, each week will feature a speaker offering a more personal and embodied look at their own generation—moving beyond data and stereotypes to tell real stories shaped by lived experience. We believe God is doing something powerful when generations listen to one another. Our hope is that this series helps us grow in understanding and grace for one another.

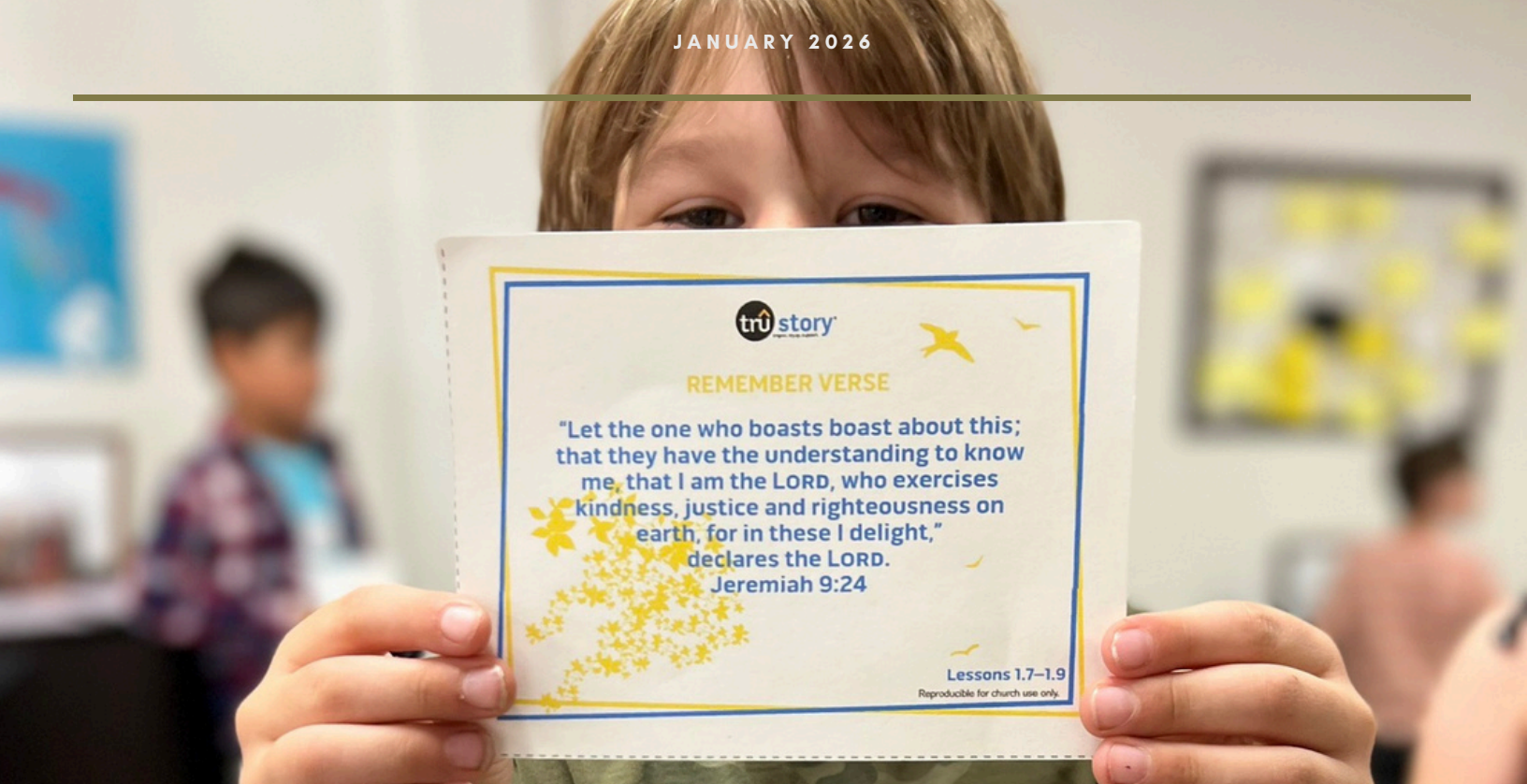
Mission & Justice
