0 - 18
Months

BABIES

- In this room, our volunteers play with and pray for your children.
- You are welcome to bring bottles, diapers, etc. Please don't bring snacks.
- Beds are available in this room for naps.
- Ask our volunteers about our Nurse and Nap area! (located in the Library)

18 Month
- 3 Years

TODDLERS

- In this room, our volunteers lead games, crafts, worship, prayer, and a portion of The Big God Story.
- We have a diaper station and children's bathroom in this room.
- You are welcome to bring bottles, diapers, water bottle etc. Please don't bring snacks.

3 - 5
Years

PRESCHOOL

- In this room, our volunteers lead games, crafts, worship, prayer, and a portion of The Big God Story. This room is similar to the Toddlers room, but with a few extra activities.
- Every child receives a prize of their choice for reciting the memory verse!
- You are welcome to bring water bottles, sensory items, etc. Please don't bring snacks.

K - 5th
Grade

ELEMENTARY

- This room meets in a blend of small and large group settings to learn about God and the Bible, have fun, and build friendships with other kids and adult leaders.
- Your kids will learn about who God is, how he has related to people throughout history, and how each of us has a part to play in his story!
- Every kid will receive stamps for participating and can use them to choose a prize!
- You are welcome to bring water bottles, sensory items, etc. Please don't bring snacks.

DROP-OFF TIPS & TRICKS

BE PREPARED

Use Church Center to register in advance so the check-in process goes smoothly

BE QUICK

Avoid a lingering good-bye as this can cause uncertainty for children and lead to escalation

BE COMFORTED

Volunteers will text you if your child is having a hard time adjusting or needs assistance

Who will be watching my child?

In NDC Kids we have an amazing group of volunteers who love investing in your kids and helping you nurture their faith. Each secure kids environment is led by background-checked, trained volunteers from our church community.

How do I inform volunteers that my child has an allergy?

While registering on the Church Center App (see Registration section of this document) you can add your child's allergies to the "Medical Notes" section. This information will be saved to your child's profile and printed on their nametag. If needed, you are also welcome to inform volunteers at drop-off. Volunteers always check a child's nametag before giving out snacks.

Can I bring my child with me to service instead?

You are always welcome to have your kid in service with you. Please know children are accepted and loved at NDC whether they attend service or an NDC Kids room. We want parents to feel comfortable leaving their children in NDC Kids on Sunday, so let our volunteers know if there is something additional your kid needs or any concerns you have.

What is the sick policy?

To protect the health of our children and volunteers, we ask that parents do not bring a child to NDC Kids if they have had any of the following symptoms within the last 24 hours: fever, unexplained rash, persistent cough or runny nose, pink eye, vomiting or diarrhea. If anyone in your household is COVID positive, please do not bring your child to NDC Kids.

Can I stay with my child in NDC Kids?

Unfortunately, no. In order to keep our kids environments secure we ask parents not to stay in the NDC Kids rooms after drop-off or pick-up. If you are worried about your child struggling during drop-off please check out the "Drop-off Tips and Tricks" section in this document.

What if my child is potty training?

Bring them! Our Toddlers and Preschool rooms have close access to a kid sized toilet. Just inform volunteers if your child needs to be reminded often to use the bathroom or any extra help they may need while using the potty.

How is my child going to be treated if they have a disability or special needs?

Our goal in NDC Kids is to be a safe place for all children to learn how to follow Jesus. If your child is not typical (neurodivergent, disabled, etc.) and requires extra assistance please notify a volunteer or the NDC Kids Director, Catherine Gates. In the Elementary room we have a "Buddy" volunteer who assists kids who are not typical or need extra attention. You are welcome to bring anything from home that your child needs (noise cancelling headphones, fidgets, etc.). Please contact the NDC Kids Director if there is anything additional your child needs.
